PROSPECTUS - Going Green – collage/assemblage

Green Lantern Studios seeks submissions for inclusion in **Going Green – collage/assemblage**, a group exhibition to run from August 2nd through September 14th, 2008.

We're looking for 2D & 3D works that explore the possibilities of re-using discarded and found objects as art. "Found" or recycled materials (natural or manufactured) and objects or fragments not intended as art materials are fair game. Smashed beer cans, old magazines, chicken bones, and broken jewelry – what are they? The castoffs of our society - or raw materials for your next collage/assemblage? Show us how you Go Green with your art!

(Please note: certain natural materials, including feathers or body parts of protected birds and animals CANNOT be legally used. Keep this in mind when creating your art.)

If you have any questions about whether something falls within these guidelines, just give us a call. As always, we want to be inclusive! And we want to have fun!

Up to 3 works per artist can be submitted for consideration by the jurors, Tom Kelly and Carole Spelic'. A \$10 fee covers our review of 1 – 3 pieces. All works submitted must be for sale.

Review of works will be by slide, CD or via e-mail (high-quality jpegs, please!), or actual work. Photographic images should represent the type of work to be exhibited. See the next page for ship-to & e-mail information.

Exhibition dates are August 2 through September 14, 2008.

Postmark deadline for submissions is July 15th. Artists will be notified of inclusion by July 21st. Plan ahead - selected work will need to arrive at the gallery by July 29th.

Accepted works will need to be shipped, or delivered, in ready-to-show condition, meaning framed art should be wired for hanging, and other works logically prepared for display.

We will return unsold works by October 10th. If you mailed them in, we'll mail them back, etc. You can also drop off the works to us in person, and then pick them up after the exhibition closes.
